**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

**Recycled Water Pipeline Construction on  
Main Street from Broadway Street to south of Del Amo Boulevard.**

- WHO:** U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and West Basin Municipal Water District.
- WHAT:** Install a recycled water pipeline on Main Street from South Broadway Street to Lenardo Drive.
- WHEN:** Construction is expected to begin mid-December 2010 and continue through June 2010. Construction signs with interchangeable messages will notify drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists of the temporary traffic re-routing along the traffic lanes. Temporary closure of sidewalks may occur during construction hours, but will be reopened at the end of each day.

Access to all businesses and residential areas will be maintained at all times. Construction will take place between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM from Monday to Friday. No construction is expected to occur on weekends or holidays.
