Construction Notice

RECYCLED WATER PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION:
DEL AMO BOULEVARD BETWEEN HENRIETTA STREET AND DONORA AVENUE

- WHO:** West Basin Municipal Water District (West Basin)
- WHAT:** Installation of four and twelve-diameter PVC Purple and Ductile Iron recycled water pipeline in Del Amo Boulevard between Henrietta Street and Donora Avenue
- WHEN:** 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Tuesday, February 15, 2011 through Monday, February 28, 2011.
Dates subject to change due to weather.
- WHERE:** In Del Amo Boulevard between Henrietta Street and Donora Avenue

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Construction signs to notify drivers, pedestrians and cyclists of construction activity and parking limits;
- Temporary re-routing of traffic flow on Del Amo Boulevard during construction work hours;
- Temporary restrictions on turns at Del Amo Boulevard and Victor Avenue during construction work hours;
- Temporary restrictions on turns at Del Amo Boulevard and Entradero Avenue during construction work hours;
- Sidewalks will be open during construction;
- Other construction impacts will include noise, minimal dust and minimal vibration;
- Drivers and bicyclists are encouraged to use alternative streets to avoid traffic congestion;
- Construction activities will include potholing, excavation, installation of pipe, trench backfilling, asphalt resurfacing and traffic control.

BACKGROUND:

This recycled water pipeline extension is part of the West Basin's *Water Reliability 2020* program to decrease our region's dependence on imported water from 66% to 33% by 2020. West Basin is extending irrigation recycled water pipelines, doubling conservation, expanding education programs and developing ocean-water desalination to protect our drinking water supply and make it more reliable. The Anza Avenue Lateral Phase II project is approx. 11,000 feet of purple recycled irrigation water pipeline that will save potable water for other purposes in the city of Torrance.
