TORRANCE BOOSTER PUMP STATION:

WEST HIGH SCHOOL PARKING LOT ON VICTOR STREET AND DEL AMO BOULEVARD

WHO: West Basin Municipal Water District (West Basin)

WHAT: Torrance Booster Pump Station Start of Construction

WHEN: Monday-Friday 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, February 14, 2011 anticipated completion August, 2011
Dates subject to change due to weather.

Monday, February 14, 2011 through Monday, February 28, 2011 expect work-site set-up, asphalt saw cutting and pavement demolition.

WHERE: In the West High School parking lot on Victor Street and Del Amo Boulevard

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Construction activities will include delivery of equipment and materials, set-up and installation of fencing and signage, saw-cutting of asphalt, demolition of pavement, removal of asphalt and pavement, and excavation;
- Other construction impacts will include noise, minimal dust and minimal vibration, and delivery of construction materials;
- Construction signs to notify drivers, pedestrians and cyclists of construction activity and parking limits;
- Sidewalks will be open during construction.

BACKGROUND:

The Torrance Booster Pump Station project is part of the West Basin's *Water Reliability 2020* program to decrease our region's dependence on imported water from 66% to 33% by 2020. West Basin is extending irrigation recycled water pipelines, doubling conservation, expanding education programs and developing ocean-water desalination to protect our drinking water supply and make it more reliable. The pump station, located on the north side of the West High School parking lot on the southeast corner of Victor Street and Del Amo Boulevard, will provide increased pressure to move and maintain recycled water to adequately serve the Anza Lateral pipeline customers with recycled water for landscape irrigation, commercial and industrial uses. The pump station will serve several parks in the city of Torrance and schools within the Torrance Unified School District with recycled water for landscape irrigation. The Torrance Booster Pump Station project will save potable water for other purposes in the city of Torrance.
