SUMMARY:

The District received an invitation to attend and make a presentation at the IDA Conference on February 25-27, 2003 in Singapore. The Conference theme is "The Role of Desalination Technologies in Urban/Rural Water Reuse". Speakers from around the world will be in attendance and the Conference should be an outstanding program.

The National Water Research Institute (NWRI) recommended that the District's General Manager speak at the conference on Economics of Water Reuse, specifically, "designer waters" at the West Basin Municipal Water District program.
