HARBOR/SOUTH BAY WATER RECYCLING PROJECT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

The following is an overview of the current projects/issues ongoing as part of the overall Harbor/South Bay Project.

**Madrona Lateral (Project Lateral 6A)**

The Project will consist of approximately 15,000 linear feet of 24-inch transmission pipeline and 10,000 linear feet of small diameter distribution laterals to serve the City of Torrance's proposed recycled water customers. The Madrona Pipeline will serve as the first segment of transmission pipeline extension necessary for serving the Palos Verdes Peninsula. The 100% design submittal was completed on June 11, 2004. The "Scope of Work" and contractor qualification criteria were prepared jointly by West Basin and the U.S. Army Corps. On July 19, 2004, these documents were posted along with the design plans and construction specifications at the U.S. Army Corps' website. Bid packages are due to the U.S. Army Corps on August 18. Once bids are received, a panel including West Basin and U.S. Army Corps staff will review all bids. A contractor will be selected through the Hubzone Best-Value Trade Off method. Award of contract is anticipated in late September or early October.

**L.A. Southwest College Lateral (Lateral 10)**

A design task order was submitted by the U.S. Army Corps to the design consultant, AKM Consulting. The design task order is anticipated to be initiated in late August.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

Funds are available in the Capital Improvements Project Budget for fiscal year 2004-05.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE:

The environmental compliance work for the recycled water pipelines included under the Harbor/South Bay Water Recycling Project has already been completed by the U.S. Army Corps.

This item was reviewed by the Water Resources Committee on August 4, 2004 and agendized to the August 23, 2004 Board meeting.
