ULTRA-LOW FLUSH TOILET (ULFT) DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM UPDATE

SUMMARY:

Several of the Districts' ULFT programs have been successfully conducted to date. Staff is currently working with each Director to coordinate the remaining programs.

West Basin

- Director Kwan
 - Harbor/Gateway Program – Currently working with the Harbor/Gateway Chamber of Commerce to coordinate an event.
- Director Fernandez
 - Both the Inglewood Meadows and the Regency Towers senior apartment complexes were contacted and offered the District's free direct install program. Both complexes declined participating in the program.
 - In order to coordinate a traditional free ULFT giveaway program, a city and community-based organization needs to be identified. If requested, a list of non-profit organizations can be provided to assist in selecting a group to help with the event.
- Director Baker
 - Staff will be working with the new Director in coordinating a program. The District has received a request from the City of Carson's Recreation and Community Services Department to hold the event in their City utilizing their group. The District has utilized the City for several programs over the years.
