URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE

SUMMARY:

The Urban Water Management Planning Act (Act) requires that urban water suppliers providing more than 3,000 acre-feet annually or 3,000 customers to prepare an Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) in years ending in five and zero. The Act describes in detail the content of the plans to be submitted to the California Department of Water Resources.

Staff has been updating the District's 2000 UWMP to reflect current information and future projected water demands, supply and reliability for the 2005 UWMP. Staff has met with many of its customer agencies to discuss the UWMP, answer questions related to the UWMP and/or projects occurring throughout the service area, and provide assistance when requested. Staff has been providing many agencies with conservation data that they will be able to use in their conservation section of the UWMP.
