RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

The following is the monthly update on the progress of the District's pursuit of recycled water customers.

- Progress continues at the California State University, Dominguez Hills campus with pipeline construction progressing satisfactorily and conversion of the irrigation system is likely to be complete by the end of September; and
- A follow-up meeting has been scheduled for October 3 with L.A. County Department of Parks and Recreation to discuss the potential for conversion of Victoria Regional Park to recycled water. Staff is hopeful more information regarding potential problems with remediation of landfill issues in the area will be available by then.
