ULTRA-LOW FLUSH TOILET (ULFT) DISTRIBUTION UPDATESUMMARY:

Two successful ULFT programs were conducted to date. To avoid the holidays and rainy season, the remaining three programs will be conducted in the February through June 2006 timeframe. Following is the status of the programs:

Division I – Director Baker

Division II – Director Fernandez

Division III – Director Kwan

Division IV – Director Little

- Through the budgeted funds for this Division, a total of 100 ULFTs were directly installed at the Culver City Rotary Plaza Senior Apartments.
- The remaining funds were used to successfully distribute 250 ULFTs to the residents of El Segundo on October 15 through a traditional distribution program. The City of El Segundo has an estimated 7,000 total housing units with a median annual income of \$61,341. In prior ULFT events, a range of 150 ULFTs have been distributed to the residents of El Segundo through these programs. Therefore, this program was considered successful. Staff is working with its vendor to close-out the program in November and to schedule the check presentation with the El Segundo Kiwanis Club.

Division V – Director Dear

- In partnership with Southern California Water Company (now Golden State), an estimated 800 ULFTs were successfully distributed to the residents of Hawthorne, Lawndale, Gardena, and El Camino Village. Of these, several new ULFTs were returned and not installed. Of the 800 ULFTs distributed, 738 ULFTs were installed and the remaining were returned. Staff is working with its vendor to close-out the program in November and to schedule the check presentation with the Hawthorne Parks and Recreation Foundation.

Staff will continue working with each Director to schedule the remaining programs.
