CONSENT CALENDAR

YEAR-TO-DATE WATER SALES – BUDGET TO ACTUALS

SUMMARY:

Staff has been monitoring West Basin’s water sales and revenues on a monthly basis for fiscal year 2005-06. The District’s year-to-date operating revenues from water sales are approximately 11% greater than fiscal year 2004-05. On a volume basis, total water sales are 2,100 acre-feet above budgeted projections, and revenues generated are 3% above budgeted sales.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

The Desalter has been shutdown since mid-January 2003 due to a broken casing at Well No. 33 and is anticipated to be back online in April 2006. Poor water quality from Hyperion has contributed to the decline in recycled water sales. Once the high-rate clarifier in Phase IV becomes operational in February 2006, recycled water sales should increase. Staff will continue to monitor, track, and report water sales on a monthly basis.
