CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

This Board memorandum provides the monthly update on the progress of West Basin's pursuit of recycled water customers.

The Aerospace Corporation – Expansion (10 AFY): This site is currently connected to the recycled water system. The irrigation system is being expanded to serve a new building that is under construction. The expanded irrigation system is anticipated to be connected to the recycled water system before the end of 2008.

Kobata Nursery (20 AFY): Staff is working with the City of Torrance and the nursery owner to connect this site to the recycled water system. The owner of the nursery has already made the majority of the modifications to the irrigation system required to connect to the recycled water system. The City of Torrance plans to build a recycled water service connection to the site this November. It is anticipated that the site will be connected to the recycled water system this December.

City of Redondo Beach Median (5 AFY): Staff is working with the City of Redondo Beach to connect a new irrigation system that will serve street landscaping to the recycled water system. The irrigation system is located on Pacific Coast Highway and Catalina Avenue. This site is anticipated to be connected to the recycled water system during the first quarter of 2009.

Raytheon (84 AFY): Staff is working with Raytheon to connect this site to the recycled water system. Raytheon is currently obtaining bids from contractors to implement the site retrofit work. It is anticipated that Raytheon will connect to the recycled water system in early 2009.

Jim Thorpe Park (20 AFY): Staff is working with the City of Hawthorne to retrofit this park to use recycled water. It is anticipated that the site will be connected to the recycled water system in April of 2009.
