Project Location: The proposed project is located in Los Angeles County and includes streets in the cities of Torrance, Carson, El Segundo, portions of City of Los Angeles and unincorporated Los Angeles County.

Project Description: The proposed project is the construction and installation of approximately an additional 2100 lineal feet of recycled water pipeline, which would deliver recycled water to various cities in Los Angeles County. The proposed pipelines will be constructed within existing road rights-of-way with other utilities. In addition, the proposed project includes the construction of a two small pumping stations to move water uphill.

The original FONSI and CEQA was certified in May 2004. Project additions required another subsequent MND. A FONSI was approved by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in August 2009. The West Basin Municipal Water District Board of Directors approved the Subsequent Mitigated Negative Declaration and accompanying Mitigation Monitoring Plan on September 28, 2009. The proposed Subsequent Mitigated Negative Declaration was available for public review May 28, 2009 until June 29, 2009. All comments were considered and included in the final document reviewed by West Basin Board of Directors.

This is to advise that the **West Basin Municipal Water District - Board of Directors** has approved the above described project on **Monday September 28, 2009** and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment with mitigation;
2. A Subsequent Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA;
3. Mitigation Measures were made a condition of the approval of the project;
4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
