CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

This Board memorandum provides the monthly update on the progress of West Basin Municipal Water District's (West Basin) pursuit of recycled water customers.

Manhattan Village Estates and HOA, Manhattan Beach (50 AFY): A preliminary retrofit design is being developed in order to connect the common area landscaping to recycled water within this gated community.

Manhattan Towers, Manhattan Beach (10 AFY): The recycled water service to this site will be built in November. Retrofit work is currently in progress and it is anticipated that this site will be connected to recycled water in December of 2009.

Virco Manufacturing Corporation, Torrance (10 AFY): Staff is working with representatives from this site to develop a retrofit design to connect the site landscaping to the recycled water system.

Washington Park, El Segundo (15 AFY): This site has already been using recycled water for irrigation. The entire irrigation system is currently being replaced. Staff is working with the City of El Segundo to obtain approval for installation of the new system from the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health.

Dominguez Tech Center, Carson (80 AFY): Staff is working with the owners of the Technology Center to develop the retrofit design for connection of the common area landscaping to the recycled water system.

Texollini, Carson (220 AFY): Texollini is a well established textile processing facility that uses a large amount of water for dyeing. Staff is working with this customer to develop a method to produce the desired water quality and retrofit design to use recycled water in the dyeing process.

STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN IMPLEMENTATION:

Goal 1, Reliability – Maintain a level of local water reliability that supports the regional economy, our community and customer agency needs.

Water Reliability – West Basin is committed to innovative planning and investments to provide water supply reliability and drought protection.
