## CONSENT CALENDAR

### RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT UPDATE

#### SUMMARY:

This Board memorandum provides the monthly update on the progress of West Basin's pursuit of recycled water customers.

Jim Thorpe Park (21 AFY): The City of Hawthorne has almost completed the retrofit construction for this site. It is anticipated that this site will be connected to the recycled water system in February of this year.

The Aerospace Corporation Expansion (10 AFY): The Aerospace Corporation has almost completed the construction of a new administration building at the El Segundo campus. The landscaping around the new building will use recycled water. The irrigation system is planned to be connected in February of this year.

El Camino College (50 AFY): The College is working on developing a "Request for Proposals" to implement the recycled water retrofit. It is anticipated that the retrofit work will be implemented in the summer of this year.

Equinix (300 AFY): Construction of the first phase of the data center has initiated. The first phase should be completed by the end of August 2009 and will use approximately 100 acre-feet of recycled water. The two remaining phases are planned to be completed in 2010.

#### STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN IMPLEMENTATION:

Goal 1, Reliability – Maintain a level of local water reliability that supports the regional economy, our community and customer agency needs.

#### COMMITMENT STATEMENT:

Water Reliability – West Basin is committed to innovative planning and investments to provide water supply reliability and drought protection.

#### FISCAL IMPACTS:

Funds for this project are included in the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Capital Improvement Program Budget.
