CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

This Board memorandum provides the monthly update on the progress of West Basin's pursuit of recycled water customers.

Jim Thorpe Park (21 AFY): The City of Hawthorne connected this site to the recycled water system February 10. The retrofit was implemented as a result of the retrofit loan approved by the Board in December 2008.

Aerospace Corporation Expansion (5 AFY): The Aerospace Corporation finished construction of a new administration building within their El Segundo Campus. The irrigation system surrounding the new building was connected to the recycled water system on February 6.

El Camino College (50 AFY): The College is in the process of installing several new irrigation systems for the campus playing fields. Once the irrigation systems are installed, the site can be connected to the recycled water system. It is anticipated that the site will be connected by October of this year.

Marriott Golf Course (50 AFY): Marriott management is evaluating the use of recycled water for irrigation again. Staff is working with a turf consultant and site management to ensure that recycled water can be used to irrigate the greens.

Manhattan Beach Towers (10 AFY): Staff is working with the customer to evaluate several retrofit design options. The building management is considering reducing the irrigated area to reduce the retrofit cost.

Kilroy Office Building (15 AFY): Staff is developing the retrofit analysis for this site. The analysis will include the use of recycled water for both irrigation and cooling towers.

Northrop Grumman Office Building (5 AFY): This office building is located across from the Los Angeles Air Force Base on Douglas Street. Staff is working with the customer to develop a retrofit analysis for this site.
