CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

This Board memorandum provides the monthly update on the progress of West Basin's pursuit of recycled water customers.

American Honda Motor Company (3 AFY): The Acura Design center at the American Honda campus in Torrance is in the process of expanding a portion of the irrigation system. This expansion is anticipated to be completed by the end of April 2009.

Los Angeles Air Force Base (5 AFY): The Los Angeles Air Force Base is in the process of expanding the existing recycled water irrigation system. The expansion is expected to be finalized in April 2009.

California State University Dominguez Hills (University) (24 AFY): The University is moving forward with the conversion of the cooling tower to the recycled water system. The cooling tower is anticipated to be connected to the recycled water system by June.

Imperial Avenue (19 AFY): The City of El Segundo is planning the conversion of Imperial Avenue Dog Park and two City-owned green areas along Imperial Avenue to the recycled water system. These sites are anticipated to be connected to the recycled water system by July 2009.

Aerospace Corporation Expansion (4 AFY): The Aerospace Corporation has started construction of another new building at the El Segundo campus. The new building landscaping is anticipated to be connected to the recycled water system in March 2010.

Goal 1, Reliability – Maintain a level of local water reliability that supports the regional economy, our community and customer agency needs.
