CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

This Board memorandum provides the monthly update on the progress of West Basin Municipal Water District's (West Basin) pursuit of recycled water customers. In addition, a short list of tasks, with the corresponding target completion dates, have been included for each future recycled water conversion.

Dominguez Technology Center (70 AFY): Staff is working with representatives from the Watson Land Company and The Carson Companies to develop the recycled water retrofit design for the landscaping within the Dominguez Technology Center. It is anticipated that this site will be connected to the recycled water system in July. (See Exhibit "A" for photos of progress.)

Ashwood Park and Rogers Park Expansion (10 AFY): Staff is working with the City of Inglewood to develop the request for construction proposals to implement the recycled water retrofit. The sites are anticipated to be connected to the recycled water system by August.

Manhattan Village Estates (50 AFY): Staff is working with the Manhattan Village gated community to convert the common area landscaping to recycled water. Staff is working on finalizing the recycled water retrofit design for this site.

American Honda (35 AFY): Staff is working with representatives from American Honda to connect the Torrance campus irrigation system to use recycled water. American Honda will obtain cost estimates to implement the recycled water conversion using the retrofit design developed by staff.

STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN IMPLEMENTATION:

Goal 1: Water Reliability – West Basin is committed to innovative planning and investments to provide water supply reliability and drought protection.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

Funds for this project are included in the Fiscal Year 2009-10 Operations Program Budget.
