CONSENT CALENDAR

RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT UPDATE

SUMMARY:

This Board memorandum provides the monthly update on the progress of West Basin Municipal Water District's (West Basin) pursuit of recycled water customers.

CalTrans 405 and Hillcrest (10 AFY): Caltrans has constructed a new recycled water irrigation system along the northbound 405 freeway from Arbor Vitae Street to Manchester Boulevard. The new irrigation system has been approved for connection to the recycled water system by the Department of Public Health (DPH). The irrigation is scheduled to be connected the last week of November.

Ashwood and Rogers Park (15 AFY): Staff is working with the City of Inglewood to retrofit Ashwood Park to recycled water and also make some irrigation modifications to the Rogers Park recycled water irrigation system. Staff will implement the work on behalf of the City using city funds. Bids for the work are scheduled to be obtained this December with construction anticipated to start in February 2011.

City of Hawthorne Medians (5 AFY): The City of Hawthorne is planning to construct medians on Inglewood Avenue between El Segundo Boulevard and Imperial Highway. The City is planning to construct a new irrigation system within the medians that will use recycled water. Staff is working with the City to determine the feasibility of connecting the entire irrigation system to recycled water.

Corporate Campus Hotel (10 AFY): A new hotel is planned at the Corporate Campus El Segundo. The landscaping for the hotel will use recycled water for irrigation. Staff is working with the hotel design engineers to ensure that the proposed design incorporates DPH requirements.

El Segundo High School (renovation): Staff is working with the school district to develop recycled water retrofit plans and to ensure that all site modifications are inspected and approved by the Los Angeles County DPH.

Redondo Union High School (renovation): Staff has been working with the school district to ensure DPH requirements for the site construction are met.

STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN IMPLEMENTATION:

Goal 1: Water Reliability – West Basin is committed to innovative planning and investments to provide water supply reliability and drought protection.

Funds for this project are included in the Fiscal Year 2010-11 Operations Program Budget.
