West Basin Municipal Water District is constructing a new recycled water pipeline that will expand recycled water use in the City of Torrance and bring the first drop of recycled water to the Palos Verdes Peninsula.

#### What to Expect

A temporary construction staging area that will store building materials and equipment will be located at Lago Seco Park in Torrance. It will remain on site at the park for approximately a year.

- The staging area will be located in the southwest corner of the park by Ladeene Avenue and 238<sup>th</sup> Street (see map below).
- Fence and privacy screening will enclose staging area.

#### Background

The Palos Verdes Recycled Water Pipeline Project is a new 3.5-mile-long recycled water pipeline that will connect to West Basin's existing system at Anza Avenue and Calle Mayor in Torrance and deliver recycled water for irrigation purposes to Lago Seco and Los Arboles "Rocketship" Parks, Richardson Middle School, Riviera Elementary School, medians on PCH and Anza Avenue and the Palos Verdes Golf Club. The project also includes a booster pump station located at Lago Seco Park in Torrance that will store the pumps needed to carry recycled water to higher elevations.
